

APP Volunteer Mentor

Duties:

Female mentors are needed for the Adolescent Parenting Program (APP) of the Children and Family Resource Center. APP mentors are friends and role models for pregnant and parenting teenagers in Henderson County. Mentors will use the Smart Girls curriculum to encourage the participants in their goals of completing their high school education, parenting and life management skills. Additional responsibilities could include volunteers assisting with transportation to and from monthly Peer Group sessions and other program events. Each volunteer will serve up to two teenagers at a time.

Qualifications:

Good communication skills, ability to relate in a friendly and helpful manner
Counseling and/or Tutoring experience helpful
High School Diploma required

The Center will conduct a comprehensive training program prior to volunteers being assigned program responsibilities.

Time Commitment:

Smart Girls Training: 7 hours
APP Training: 2 hours
3 one-on-one meetings with each participant per month: 2 - 4 hours
Monthly Peer Group Meetings (3 per year): 2 hours/month

A one year commitment is needed.
